**AN ORDINANCE
TO
AMEND CHAPTER 257
OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"Vehicles and Traffic"**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will establish the speed limit on Brook Lane at 15 mph..

WHEREAS, the residents of Brook Lane have requested that certain traffic calming measures be implemented on Brook Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed this request and has suggested the implementation of fifteen (15 mph) miles per hour speed limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood "Vehicles and Traffic" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-38 Schedule II: Speed Limits

Shall be amended by adding the following:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u> (mph)	<u>Location</u>
Brook Lane	15	Entire Length

All other sections shall remain unchanged.

SECOND : Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD : Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication according to law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on August 6, 2013 and that Committee met again on September 3, 2013, at 7:30 p.m. at the Maplewood Police and Court Building, 1618 Springfield Avenue, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
