ORDINANCE

2733-13

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE TIMES THAT CONSTRUCTION WORK IS PERMITTED WITHIN MAPLEWOOD

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will prohibit excavation, demolition, construction, repair or alteration work from beginning before 8:00 a.m. on Saturdays and 11:00 a.m. on Sundays.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

FIRST:

Excavation, demolition, construction, repair, or alteration work shall be conducted only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on weekdays, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Saturdays and between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sundays. In case of urgent necessity or in the interests of public health or safety, the Director of Public Works may grant a permit for excavation, demolition, construction, repair of streets, sidewalks and bridges or alteration work for a period necessary to complete said work.

The Code of the Township of Maplewood Chapter 181 shall be amended per the above.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on October 1, 2013, and that Committee met again on October 15, 2013, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
