RESOLUTION APPOINTING PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER
FOR THE YEAR 2014
(Cesar R. Correa, Jr.)

WHEREAS, it has long been the policy of the State of New Jersey to promote equal opportunity by prohibiting discrimination in employment and requiring affirmative action in the performance of contracts funded by the State; and

WHEREAS, this policy was reinforced and expanded by an Act of the Legislative, signed into law by the Governor on June 23, 1975; and

WHEREAS, P. L., 1975. C. 127, provides that no public work contracts can be awarded nor any monies paid until the prospective contractor has agreed to contract performance with complies with an affirmative action program; and

WHEREAS, the provision of N.J.A.C. 17:27, et seq. requires municipalities to appoint an employee to serve as a Public Agency Compliance Officer (PACO) to ensure the municipality's compliance with the law;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that, Cesar Correa shall serve as PACO for the Township of Maplewood for the year 2014.
