RESOLUTION OF CONTINUING SUPPORT FOR THE GOALS AND PURPOSES OF THE 2004 HIGHLANDS WATER PROTECTION AND PLANNING ACT

WHEREAS, New Jersey Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act ("the Highlands Act") was enacted in order to protect New Jersey's Water supplies and other significant resources; and

WHEREAS, the Highlands Act was passed with overwhelming bipartisan support in both the New Jersey State Senate and the New Jersey State Assembly; and

WHEREAS, subsequently in 2008, the New Jersey Highlands Water Protection and Planning Council adopted the New Jersey Highlands Regional Master Plan, and proceeded with a program for its implementation through a Plan Conformance process.

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood ("Maplewood") is a municipality that receives all or a portion of its drinking water from sources within the Highlands Region; and

WHEREAS, Maplewood relies on the resources of the Highlands to meet the current and future needs of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

It wishes it be known that Maplewood strongly supports the goals, policies and objectives of the 2004 Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act and the Highlands Regional Master Plan.
