RESOLUTION EXPRESSING DISPLEASURE WITH THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

WHEREAS, over the last several weeks, U.S. Mail Service to the homeowners in the Township of Maplewood ("Township") has been inconsistent or nonexistent; and

WHEREAS, numerous residents of the Township have complained that they have not received U.S. Mail Service for four (4) to seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, inquiries to the local United States Postal Service authorities have been unsatisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

- (1) The Maplewood Township Committee does express its displeasure with the United States Postal Service in connection with its unsatisfactory delivery of mail to U.S. Postal Service customers within the Township of Maplewood.
- (2) A copy of this Resolution be sent to Senator Robert Menendez, Senator Cory Booker, Congressman Donald Payne, Jr., and to the Regional Post Master and to the local Post Master.
