AUTHORIZATION FOR CHANGE ORDER #2

FOR

UPPER RIDGEWOOD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS –CONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, on **May 7, 2013**, Contract was awarded to **Rock Solid Construction**. in the amount of \$641,821.60 for the Upper Ridgewood Drainage Improvements –Construction; and

WHEREAS, Change Order #1 for \$30,308.70 (4.72%), was previously approved; and

WHEREAS, additional construction, specifically a bypass chamber is required for a previously unmarked, undiscovered 16” water main owned by United Water and serving the City of Orange; and

WHEREAS, additional construction is required, specifically to realign the piping under a previously unmarked, undiscovered 20” water main owned by United Water and serving the City of Orange; and

WHEREAS, the cost for these additional services shall be in an amount not to exceed \$79,563.45, over the contract amount of \$641,821.60 for a total contract amount of \$751,693.75 or 17.1% over the original value; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer recommends the approval of this change order #2 in order to progress with the project.

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for this purpose.

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator recommends the approval of this change order #2 in order to progress with the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, and State of New Jersey hereby authorizes the change order #2 for an amount not to exceed \$79,563.45.
