**AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 123
OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"FEES"**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will adjust certain fees for the Maplewood Police Department Record Bureau and Court discovery pursuant to Court Rule.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Rules of Court have recently been amended to include a section regarding the amounts that may be charged for discovery; and

WHEREAS, the Maplewood Police Department and the Maplewood Courts are required to be in compliance with this Rule change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that Chapter 123 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Fees" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 123-5 Police Department Record Bureau Fees

Shall be amended to read as follows:

- A. Except as set forth in subsection B of this Section 123-5, the following fees shall be charged by the Maplewood Police Department Record Bureau:

Accident Reports/Incident Reports	\$ 5.00
Letter of Good Conduct (per set)	\$15.00
Photographs (per set)	\$20.00
Fingerprint cards (per card) Residents Only	\$15.00
Canvassing Permits (per year)	\$30.00
Audio Tapes (per disk/media)	\$30.00

Videotapes (per disk/media)	\$30.00
Special Requests or Records	Special Rate Calculation

- B. The fee for all other reports and discovery requests shall be as permitted pursuant to New Jersey Court Rules 3:13-5(a) and 7:7-7(i), as may be revised from time to time by the Administrative Director of the Courts.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT 60 WOODLAND ROAD

WHEREAS, the consumption of alcoholic beverages upon the Property is prohibited unless specifically permitted; and

WHEREAS, the consumption of alcoholic beverages upon the Property will enhance the use and benefit of the Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

1. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed on the Property upon the expressed permission of the Township Business Administrator.
2. This Resolution shall remain in effect through December 31, 2014.
