ORDINANCE # 2751-14

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 257 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

This ordinance will designate new time limits for parking on Lenox Place.

WHEREAS, the residents of Lenox Place have asked the Maplewood Township Committee to evaluate changes to the parking situation, as a result of the Post Office relocation; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to further restrict parking on Lenox Place; and

WHEREAS these changes have been reviewed and accepted by the Planning and Engineering Committee, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, in the County of Essex and State of New Jersey that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "**Vehicles and Traffic, Article VI: Schedules**" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-51 – Schedule XV: Parking Prohibited Between Certain Times and On Certain Streets is deleted as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours/Days</u>	<u>Location</u>
Lenox Place	North	8:00 a.m. to 6:00p.m./ Monday to Friday	From South Orange-Maplewood line to the line of the Essex County Park Commission

SECOND: Section 257-51 – Schedule XV: Parking Prohibited Between Certain Times and On Certain Streets is added as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours/Days</u>	<u>Location</u>
Lenox Place	North	6:00 a.m. to 6:00p.m./ Monday to Saturday	From Ridgewood Road to Maplewood Avenue

THIRD: If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

FOURTH: Whole Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

FIFTH: This Ordinance shall take effect on final passage and publication according to law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held June 17, 2014 and that the Committee met again on July 1, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. at the Police/Municipal Court Building, 1618 Springfield Avenue, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
