**RESOLUTION
REGARDING APPOINTMENT OF EXPERT FOR THE
SUPERVISION OF A DEMOLITION AND ASBESTOS
REMOVAL AT 57 MAPLEWOOD AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood (Township) has determined due to safety and health issues to demolish the property at 57 Maplewood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, an inspection of the property has indicated that there is asbestos located on the property; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to secure the services of an expert in the area of asbestos management; and

WHEREAS, the Township solicited proposals from various firms with regard to asbestos management and demolition oversight; and

WHEREAS, quotations were received from Matrix New World in the amount of \$6,525.00 and Ahera Consultants in the amount of \$6,540.00; and

WHEREAS, Matrix New World has previously done satisfactory work for the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that Matrix New World be retained to:

1. Prepare specifications for the demolition and asbestos abatement at 57 Maplewood Avenue;
2. Provide supervision services for the demolition and abatement removal at 57 Maplewood Avenue; and
3. The Township Administrator and Township Clerk be and are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Matrix New World for the providing of the aforementioned services at a cost of \$6,525.00.
