A RESOLUTION REGARDING MAPLEWOOD MEMORIAL POST 10120 VETERAN'S OF FOREIGN WARS-LAPSE OF CLUB LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, the Maplewood Memorial Post 10120 Veterans of Foreign Wars Club Liquor License Number 0711-31-016-002 has not been renewed with a 2013-2014 or 2014-2015 renewal application and filing fees; and

WHEREAS, a licensee is required to file a renewal application along with the municipal and state filing fees annually (July 1 thru June 30); and

WHEREAS, the Maplewood Memorial Post 10120 Veterans of Foreign Wars has expressed to the Maplewood Local A.B.C. that they are no longer interested in renewing the Club License as they have not utilized the license; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 33:1-12.18, a licensee who fails its renewal application and pay the annual fees on or before July 30 of the year beginning the license term for which renewal is sought (July 30, 2013 for the 2013-2014 license term), a 12.18 Special Ruling is required. The statute permits a licensee to petition the Director within one year (until July 30 of the year ending the license term for the 2013-2014 license term) and request a Special Ruling to permit the filing of an application for a new license upon failure to timely renew; and

WHEREAS, since the licensee failed to do any of the above remedies to keep the license active:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Maplewood Memorial Post 10120 Veterans of Foreign Wars Club Liquor License Number 0711-31-016-002 has lapsed and ceased to exist as of June 30, 2013.
