WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood ("Township") authorized the receipt of bids for Maplecrest Skate Park Improvements (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, bids were received on March 25, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the base bids received were:

Kal Tech Engineering	\$111,695.00
Tec-Con Contractors	\$123,500.00
Let It Grow, Inc.	\$134,425.50
Picerno Giordano Construction	\$148,122.00
Adamo Brothers Construction Co.	\$183,430.00

WHEREAS, the bids received did not meet the specification requirements or exceeded the cost estimates for the Project; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the bids be rejected; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the Project be rebid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

1. The Bids for Maplecrest Skate Park Improvements received on March 25, 2015, be and are hereby rejected, as not meeting the bid specifications or being in excess of the cost estimate for the Project;
2. All bidders shall be notified of the decision of the Township Committee to

reject the bids received;

3. The Township Business Administrator be and is hereby authorized to re-advertise for Maplecrest Skate Park Improvements, as soon as possible.
