ORDINANCE # 2786-15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 257 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

Interpretative Statement

This ordinance will add Academy Street to the list of streets prohibiting parking within 5 feet of a driveway.

WHEREAS, the Township prohibits parking within 5 feet of a driveway on certain streets;
and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has expressed concern over parking on Academy Street; and

WHEREAS, certain residents of Academy Street expressed concern over drivers parking too close to their driveways and restricting access to the street; and

WHEREAS these changes have been reviewed and accepted by the Planning and Engineering Committee, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, in the County of Essex and State of New Jersey that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "**Vehicles and Traffic, Article VI: Schedules**" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-28.2 – Parking too close to a driveway is added as follows:

Name of Street

Academy Street

SECOND: If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

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THIRD: Whole Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

FOURTH: This Ordinance shall take effect on final passage and publication according to law

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held April 21, 2015 and that the Committee met again on May 5, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. at the Maplewood Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
