ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(f) OF BOND  
ORDINANCE NUMBERED 2744-14 OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF  
ESSEX, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED MARCH  
18, 2014 IN ORDER TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL  
PROJECTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
MAPLEWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all  
members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(f) of Bond Ordinance numbered 2744-14 of the Township of  
Maplewood, in the County of Essex, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted March 18,  
2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Purpose	Appropriation and Estimated Cost	Estimated Maximum Amount of Bonds or Notes	Period of Usefulness
<b>f) <u>Administration:</u></b> Acquisition of Life-Cycle Program equipment, a computer server, vehicle tracking systems and other hardware and software, including all related costs and expenditure incidental thereto.	\$97,282	\$92,418	5 years

Section Two. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a  
temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township  
is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any  
inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with

the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
