**AN ORDINANCE
TO REQUIRE APPLICANTS
FOR AN ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION
PLACE TO PLACE LIQUOR LICENSE
TO PROVIDE NOTICE
TO ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS
WITHIN A 200 FOOT RADIUS
OF THE LOCATION OF THE PROPERTY
WHERE THE LICENSE IS TO BE LOCATED**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will require applicants for an ABC "Place to Place" Liquor License to give adjoining property owners within two hundred (200') feet notice of the proposed location.

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Maplewood Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission ("ABC"), reviews applications for "Place to Place" Liquor License transfers; and

WHEREAS, the ABC wishes to require applicants for "Place to Place" Liquor License transfers to give notice to adjoining properties owners within two hundred (200') feet of the location to which the license is to be located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

FIRST: Notice of a hearing on a Maplewood Alcohol Beverage Control Commission "Place to Place" Liquor License transfer shall be given at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing by the applicant to all property owners as shown on the current tax duplicates, located within two hundred (200') feet in all directions of the proposed new location. The notice shall be given by: (i) serving a copy thereof on the property owner as shown on the current tax duplicate, or his agent in charge of the property, or (ii) mailing a copy thereof by certified mail to the property owner at his/her address as shown on the current tax duplicate.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on October 6, 2015, and that Committee met again on October 20, 2015, at 7:30 p.m., at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
