RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE ESSEX COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO INSTALL AN ELEVATOR IN THE WOODLAND

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood desires to have its public accommodations be ADA-compliant, and

WHEREAS, the Township owns a cultural arts and event facility located at 60 Woodland Road, known as "The Woodland," and

WHEREAS, the second and third floors of The Woodland are inaccessible to physically-challenged individuals, and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that installing an elevator in the Woodland will provide all individuals access to the entire building in compliance with the ADA, and

WHEREAS, Essex County has funding available through its Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program for municipalities to make public facilities ADA-compliant, and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearings related to this grant application was published in The Star Ledger on November 4th, 2015, and

WHEREAS, public hearings related to this grant application were held on Monday, November 16 and Tuesday, December 1, 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that the Township of Maplewood does authorize the Chair of the Township Committee or its designated agent to submit an application for funding under the 2016 Essex County Community Development Block Grant Program to install an elevator in the Woodland.
