AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 257
OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

"Interpretive Statement"

This Ordinance will prohibit parking on the south side of DeHart Road within twenty-five (25) feet from its intersection with Ridgewood Road.

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood Engineering Department has reviewed the parking on DeHart Road; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has made a recommendation to restrict parking along the south side of DeHart Road near its intersection with Ridgewood Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-49, Schedule XIII. Parking Prohibited at all Times, shall be amended by adding the following:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
DeHart Road	South	From the south east corner of Ridgewood Road to a point 25 feet east thereof.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on May 3, 2011 and that Committee met again on May 17, 2011, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
