AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 257 OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD

Entitled
"Vehicles and Traffic"

"Interpretive Statement"

This Ordinance will increase the combined jitney feelparking permit fee to \$225.00 and will increase the commuter parking fee to \$210.00, effective January 1, 2012.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-33: Parking Restricted.

- a. No person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified and on the days specified upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule XXV (Section 257-61) attached to and made a part of this Chapter, unless the vehicle shall bear a valid permit. A Township Resident may purchase a permit. The cost of a permit on an annual basis (January 1 through December 31), shall be two hundred ten (\$210.00) dollars. Any permit issued after June 30th of the permit year shall cost one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the regular permit fee.
- b. A Township Resident may purchase a combined Jitney Bus Pass (See Section 155-1) and Parking Permit. The cost of a combined pass/permit on an annual

basis (January 1 through December 31), shall be two hundred twenty-five (\$225.00) dollars. Any pass/permit issued after June 30th of the pass/permit year shall cost one-half (1/2) of the regular pass/permit fee.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2012, and after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on September 20, 2011, and that Committee met again on October 4, 2011, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
