**AN ORDINANCE
TO DISSOLVE THE MAPLEWOOD
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will dissolve the Maplewood Economic Development Advisory Committee.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood created the Maplewood Economic Development Advisory Committee pursuant to Ordinance #2165-01; and

WHEREAS, the Maplewood Township Committee thereafter amended and/or revised the Economic Development Advisory Committee pursuant to Ordinance number 2419-07 and Ordinance number 2614-10; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is no longer a need for the Economic Development Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that all ordinances creating or supplementing the Maplewood Economic Development Advisory Committee be and are hereby repealed and the Maplewood Economic Development Advisory Committee is hereby dissolved.

Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on April 3, 2012, and that Committee met again on April 17, 2012, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
