AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 257
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"Vehicles and Traffic"

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will provide for commuter parking for low speed vehicles and plug-in electric drive vehicles on Dunnell Road between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. weekdays.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Definitions:

Low Speed Vehicles

Low Speed Vehicles means a four (4) wheel low speed vehicle, as defined in 49 C.F.R. '571.3(b), whose obtainable speed is more than twenty (20 mph) miles per hour but not more than twenty-five (25 mph) miles per hour on a paved level surface and which is not powered by gasoline or diesel fuel and complies with Federal Safety Standards as set forth in 49 C.F.R. '571.500.

Plug-in Electric Drive Vehicles

Plug-in Electric Drive Vehicles means a vehicle that:

- (a) draws motive power from a battery with a capacity of at least four (4) kilowatt-hours;

(b) can be recharged from an external source of electricity for motive power.

Electric Cars

Low Speed Vehicles and Plug-in Electric Drive Vehicles as herein defined.

SECOND: Electric Cars Only Permit Parking:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours/Days</u>	<u>Location</u>
Dunnell Road	East	5:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Weekdays	From a point 593 feet north of Baker Street to point 36 feet north thereof

THIRD: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

FOURTH: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FIFTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on January 19, 2010, and that Committee met again on February 2, 2010, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
