AN ORDINANCE  
TO AMEND  
CHAPTER 47  
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD  
ENTITLED  
"OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND ADVISORY COMMITTEE"

*"Interpretive Statement"*

*This ordinance will specify that the Maplewood Township Committee Members and Maplewood Township Employees who are members of this committee will be non-voting members of this committee. It will also add a fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) Township resident to the committee.*

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Section 47-4 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Open Space Trust Fund Advisory Committee/Membership; appointment" shall be amended to read as follows:

**FIRST:** Section 47-4. Membership; appointment.

- A. The Maplewood Open Space Trust Fund Advisory Committee shall be comprised of the following members:
- (1) A member of the Township Committee (ex officio), who shall serve as a non-voting member.
  - (2) The Director of Recreation, Parks & Cultural Affairs (ex officio), who shall serve as a non-voting member.
  - (3) The Director of Public Works (ex officio), who shall serve as a non-voting member.
  - (4) A member of the Recreation Advisory Committee, to be recommended by the Recreation Advisory Committee.
  - (5) A member of the Environmental Advisory Committee, to be recommended by the Environmental Advisory Committee.
  - (6) A member of the Historic Preservation Committee, to be recommended by the Historic Preservation Committee.

- (7) A representative of the South Orange/Maplewood School District, to be recommended by the school district.
- (8) Five (5) residents of the Township with an interest in recreation and/or parks.

B. All members shall be appointed by the Township Committee.

**SECOND:**

All other sections of Chapter 47 shall remain unchanged.

**THIRD: Severability**

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**FOURTH: Repeal of Prior Ordinances**

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

**FIFTH: Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on January 19, 2010, and that Committee met again on February 2, 2010, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
