AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 257
OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

"Interpretive Statement"

This Ordinance will allow employees of the South Orange/Maplewood Board of Education working at Jefferson School to park on Brookside Road and Maryland Road in parking spaces otherwise time restricted.

WHEREAS, employees of the South Orange/Maplewood Board of Education working at Jefferson School have a need for additional employee parking; and

WHEREAS, the Maplewood Transportation Advisory Committee has made a recommendation concerning additional on street employee parking.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Section 257-20 Time Limit Parking of the Code of the Township of Maplewood be amended to read as follows:

- (A) No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit shown in Schedule XVII (Section 257-53) at any time between the hours listed in said schedule on any day, unless otherwise indicated upon any of the streets or part of streets described in said scheduled.
- (B) The following vehicles shall be exempt from the parking limitations of this Section.
 - (a) South Orange/Maplewood Board of Education employees working at Jefferson School provided that the employee vehicle has displayed a current parking permit on its left rear window in such a manner as to be plainly visible to police personnel; and

- (b) Provided the employee vehicle is parked on the west side of Brookside Road between Jefferson Avenue and a point 123 feet south thereof or on the north side of Maryland Road from a point 60 feet east of Ridgewood Road to a point 260 feet east of Ridgewood Road or on the north side of Maryland Road from a point 436 feet east of Ridgewood Road to Brookside Road.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on March 16, 2010, and that Committee met again on April 6, 2010, at 7:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
