AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 123
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"FEES"

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will delete an inconsistency concerning the road opening permit fees.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that Chapter 123 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled "Fees" be amended as follows:

FIRST: Chapter 239 Streets and Sidewalks

B. Article III, Excavations by Utilities Companies

- (1) The following sections of this article contained hereinabove shall not apply to any public utility company as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2-13, as amended: '239-A(2)(a)[2], (b), (c) and (d).

Shall be deleted.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law.
