**AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 257 OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
Entitled
AVehicles and Traffic@**

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will change time limit parking from two (2) to (3) hours in Parking Areas 1, 6 and 8.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 257 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled AVehicles and Traffic@ be amended as follows:

FIRST: Section 257-53 - Schedule XVII: Time Limit Parking shall be amended to read as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Time Limit: Hours/Days</u>	<u>Location</u>
Parking Area #1	-	3hrs; 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All except Sunday	Along the east and west sides of Maplecrest Park, Tuscan Road & Springfield Avenue
Parking Area #6	-	3hrs; 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All except Sunday	North of Springfield Avenue and east of Yale Street on the southerly curb line thereof.
Parking Area #8	-	3hrs; 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All except Sunday	Springfield Avenue and Indiana Street - east, west and south curbs.

SECOND: If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and publication according to law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held November 5, 2003, and that the Committee met again on November 17, 2003, at 8:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building, Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
